I picked this book because maybe her story will help other abducted children or more people to become involved and report suspicious activity.

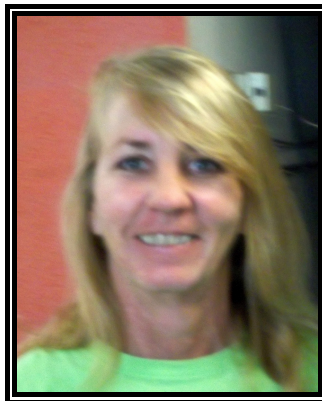

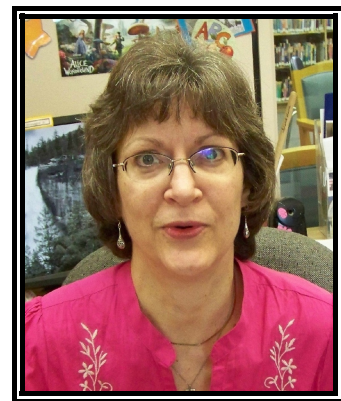
