**Fall Book Sale**

Our annual Fall Book Sale is scheduled for the first week of October. Thursday, October 4, is the first day. With this message, I wish to discuss FOL efforts at communicating using digital methods.

At this time we have 114 members (individual, family, sustaining, and life) on record as wishing digital delivery of information. Note: that I say "on record," which doesn't necessarily mean all those are receiving the e-mail notification of news. Nor does it mean that those receiving digital mail are not also receiving USPS mail. Nor does it mean that all members are receiving any information from FOL.

As in any change of procedures, errors and stumbles are expected. If any member is receiving both hard copy and digital and don't want both please let me know using contact information at the bottom of this page. And if you are receiving none or in a format you do not wish, also contact me. Note, if you pick up the FOL Bookplate at the library, FOL considers this none, because we have no record of who or whose address.

We are implementing multiple digital request from family and life members.

We are also attempting to implement digital request for those who have provided no address.

And in addition, we are attempting to honor requests from non-members.

All summed, we are delivering to many more e-addresses than 114.

Several issues have emerged that we did not anticipate. So far all issues have been addressed. There may however be a glitch or two in implementation.

Please note that members for which we have no e-address or notification that digital reception is the preferred method, are being contacted by FOL.

All things considered, FOL believes all is going well.

And thank you for bearing with us.
