Print into the Homes -- Children's Book Sale

Thanks to a generous donation of books from Harrison Junior High Library as well as other donors, this year's Children's Book Sale shoppers had perhaps the most varied selection of books ever. We began the sale with about 75 banana boxes of books, and there were only 20 boxes left when the sale was over. The library's summer reading program distributed those left among their participants.

Our total sales topped \$470.00 Considering hardbacks were \$.25 and soft cover books were \$.10, it is obvious that lots of books walked out of the library in the hands of children and parents and into homes.

What fabulous news for the clients we serve, for our community, our state, and ultimately our nation, BECAUSE research from 27 nations points out that children can gain up to an extra three years of schooling if there are books in the home. Only 20 books can make a difference!

Special thanks to everyone who worked to make this endeavor a success. Your time and energy were much appreciated.

Dear Friends,

School has started and as usual, FOL members delivered 500 books to ABC and Headstart preschools throughout Boone County. Late in August we packed 25 books in 20 boxes (see photo herein) and started traveling. One box of 25 was left at each classroom: Alpena, 1; Omaha, 2; Lead Hill, 2; Bergman, 3; Valley Springs, 2; Harrison, 10.

These mini libraries of 25 books are rotated monthly. Each month a child is exposed to 25 different books or 200 in an 8 month school year. The books can be checked out the old-fashioned method, by signing a card that is left with the school teacher. The child can read or be read to, at school and at home.

These books are purchased by FOL and are duplicates of the Boone County Library collection. They are duplicates so as not to negatively impact the availability of books in the library collection.

This program is very successful, as measured by the enthusiasm of children and teachers.

And perhaps we may be helping a child or two gain that most valuable attribute, being able to read.




