Talking about feeling good about myself: It is always this time of year as school starts. It is the greetings and salutations from teachers and students I receive upon delivering a 25 book mini-library to ABC and Head Start classrooms. I am under the impression that this is the most appreciated thing I do. Volunteer work is where one can stumble upon or into situations that yield good feelings about one's self.

FOL provides some 20 ABC and Head Start preschools with in Boone County with these 25 book mini-libraries. They are refreshed with different books monthly such that a child can peruse 200 books over an eight month school year. The children can check out these books. Thus, they can read or be read to at home as well as school.

Special thanks is due Nancy Loveland who has been involved in this preschool program since the beginning. She delivers books to two schools in Valley Springs, and she also reads to the children there. What a champion in aiding our youth!

FOL has recently come into possession of a collection of over 1600 comic books. Most appear to have never been read. We are now evaluating them.
