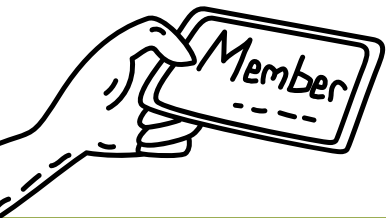

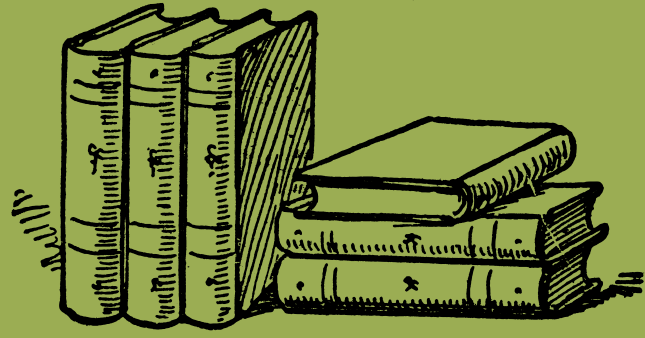

Support Local

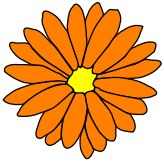

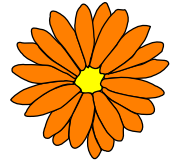
