It has been a busy first quarter for the Friends. We held the Spring Book Sale in April and the Children's Sale in May. The two sales combined brought in \$4,000.00. As always, the funds go to the library for books and other media. The Friends budgeted to help pay for the Children's Summer Reading Program and we also gave funds to the Genealogy Dept.

The State Library is helping set up a network of Friends of the Library groups through out the state of Arkansas. Friends of the Library, Boone County, met via Zoom with the coordinator of this network, Janine Miller, and were able to talk about ways to increase our membership and raise money for our library. Several good ideas came out of this conversation, one of which was a Junior Friend membership for younger school age children to get them involved with the library and the joys of volunteering.

We also have replaced the heavy wood tables that we use for the book sales with lighter weight plastic tables. For those that have been involved in either setting up or taking down a sale this is a much-appreciated change.

The board decided that it is necessary to have an over-stock sale. The purpose is to clean out of storage the books that haven't sold in the last three sales. This sale will be August 5th and 6th, 2022. Mark your calendars, we will be calling for help. This sale will be a BYOB (Bring Your Own Bag) and any size bag will go out the door for \$3.00.

I am encouraging Friends members to consider having their Bookplates e-mailed to them. This means you will get your newsletter faster and it saves the Friends the cost of printing newsletters, envelopes and stamps – which are going up in price, like everything else. 


