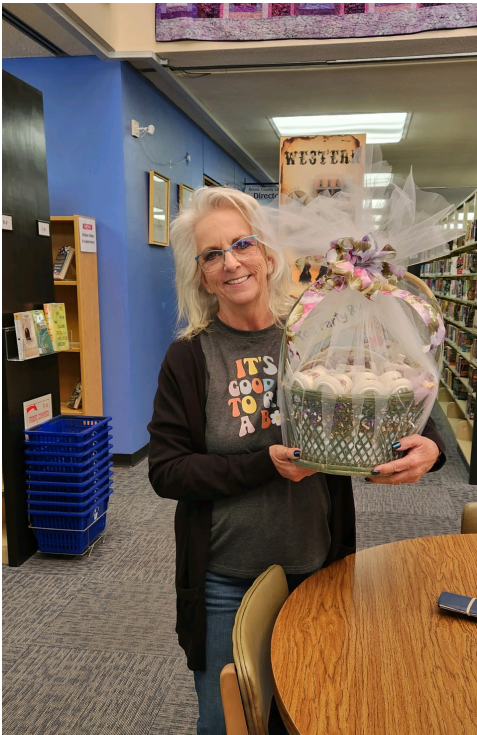

The Mother's Day basket that we raffled was won by our own Ginger Schoenenberger. We raised \$166.00! Thanks to all who entered the drawing. The Fourth of July raffle is in progress as I write. I hope it does as well.

Both the Spring Book Sale and the Young Adult & Children book sale did well. The spring sale had stiff competition with the Springfield library system sale the same weekend and then the heavy rain, but we pulled thru with a total of \$3,114.69. The Children's sale raised \$643.95. Thank you to our membership for all the volunteer hours worked and the community for all the support. As you know every dime, we raise goes to the library to purchase new media for our patrons use. The Fall Book Sale date has been changed to October 12, 13, and 14. So please remark your calendars.

This month I am working on registering Friends of the Library, Boone County, Arkansas with Candid. Candid is a registry of transparency for non-profits that is used by corporations and foundations when they have funds to donate. By registering, FOL will have a larger presence when funds are available and therefore a greater chance of receiving some of that money. We started at the Bronze Level, completed the Silver Level and have this week achieved the Gold Level of Transparency.

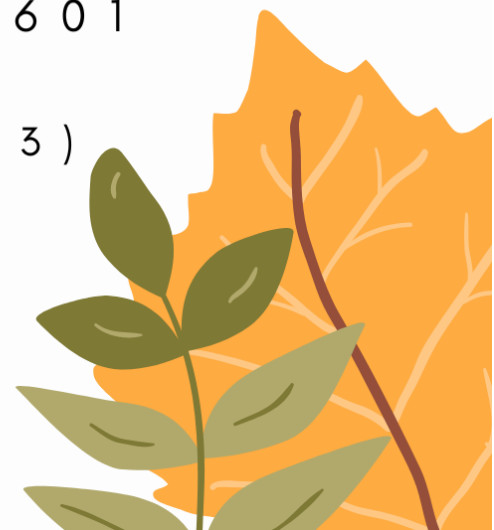

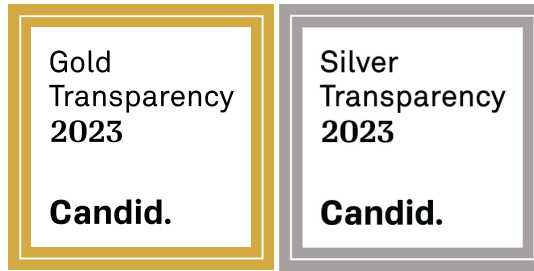
