2013 Fall Book Sale Results

A special thanks to our donors, patrons and volunteers who continue to step forward in their support of Friends of the Library and the Boone County Library. The proceeds from the first day sales possibly exceeded any other recent sale. The total profit was \$4,277.50 which included donations, memberships and book purchases. To those who donate such fine selections, to the volunteers who assist with each day of the sale from set-up to packing up Saturday afternoon and to those who attend and purchase books, we thank you.

On Wednesday, 27 volunteers worked 68 hours and 15 minutes to set-up the sale. A total of 26 volunteers worked 72 hours and 15 minutes on Thursday. On Friday, 45 hours and 45 minutes were worked by the 18 volunteers. The 20 volunteers on Saturday worked 56 hours and 15 minutes. A total of 242 hours and 30 minutes were worked during this sale, plus Malinda's time calling and formulating the assignment sheet.
