Does "Country Potato Kettle" sound like a tempting dish on a chilly fall or winter day? You can find the recipe in *Sassafras, the Ozark Cookbook* at the FOL Fall Book Sale, October 2, 3, and 4. An advance look at some of the many great donations can be seen in the library display cases for the two weeks before the sale. We want to thank all the patrons of the Boone County Library who have donated books.

An estate donation provided some excellent books on aviation and engineering. Also from this collection, two volumes were placed in the library's genealogy room. These two volumes are: *Fighting Men of Louisiana in World War II*, a companion piece to the *Arkansas Soldiers* volume (in the genealogy room) and a hard to find *History of Doddridge County, West Virginia*.

For the history buff, check out *Arms and Armor in Colonial America* and biographies of the famous and the infamous include Sam Houston, Abraham Lincoln, Jesse James, and Billy the Kid.

An interesting addition to a 1940's Compton's Encyclopedia is a war supplement.

Knowing that many of you are interested in American Indians, be sure to look for *People of Legend: Native Americans of the Southwest*, *The Smithsonian Book of North American Indians*, *Southwestern Jewelry*, and the *Dictionary of American Indians*.

We have the best selection of classics ever including Charles Dickens, Mark Twain, Harold Bell Wright, and Gene Stratton-Porter. Books by Stratton-Porter include: *The Magic Garden*, *Freckles*, and *The White Flag*.

Sets of interest include a complete set of *Britannica's Great Books*, a multi-volume *Art of Woodworking*, and a 1993 *Britannica Encyclopedia* with macro and micro volumes.

Also, we have books on nature, Arkansas and the Ozarks, crafts, home and garden, how-to, health, inspirational, reference, education, war and politics, science, art, poetry, fiction, videos, and many paperbacks.
