Hundreds of gently used and well loved books will be priced for young shoppers at 50 cents for hardcover books and 20 cents for soft cover books. Children with library cards and children under 6 years of age whose parents present a library card will be charged half price. Library cards can be obtained, with a parent's signature, on the day of the sale or any other day that the library is in operation.

We are able to keep offering these special child-priced books each year because of the generous donation of your child's outgrown books. Selected titles will be displayed in the showcases at the foot of the stairs beginning May 26. Check out these colorful reading treasures.
